ORDER

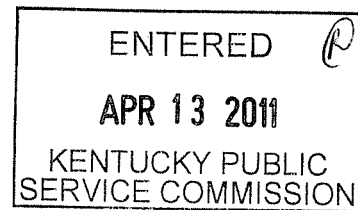
On November 29, 2010, the Commission entered an Order establishing a briefing schedule that required the simultaneous filing of briefs on February 4, 2011 and the simultaneous filing of reply briefs on February 25, 2011. On February 26, 2011, the parties to this case filed a joint request for an extension of time until March 11, 2011 in which to file their simultaneous reply briefs. As grounds for their motion, the parties state that the counsel for BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T Kentucky") that was responsible for the preparation of the reply brief was hospitalized prior to the due date for the filing of the reply briefs and was unable to prepare AT&T Kentucky's reply brief for filing. dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C. does not object

to the extension. The Commission finds that good cause exists to grant the joint motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The motion is granted.
2. The Parties' reply briefs are accepted filed as of March 11, 2011.
