NOTICE OF PROPOSED ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") proposes to construct a 161 kV transmission line to run from KU's Grahamville substation in McCracken County to the transmission line of Electric Energy, Inc. near the United States Department of Energy property in McCracken County. A map showing the route of the proposed line is shown below. KU plans to file an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") on or after November 15, 2010, seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing construction of the proposed transmission line. The purpose of the application with the Commission is to determine whether the proposed transmission line is required by the public convenience and necessity. Any interested person, including a person over whose property the proposed transmission line will cross, may request intervention in this proceeding, and may request that the Commission conduct a public hearing in McCracken County.

To seek intervention in the Commission's proceeding on KU's application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the proposed transmission line, or to request a local public hearing in that case, contact the Executive Director, Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P.O.
