

The purpose of this hearing shall be the cross-examination of witnesses of Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation on its application for adjustment of its security deposit and cable television attachment rates.

#### ADVERTISERS REQUIRED FOR LUMP SUM BIDS

The Grant County Fiscal Court invites qualified suppliers of public warning systems to respond to the following Request for Lump Sum Bid Proposal for a turn-key fire alarm system and fire alarm control panel at the Grant County Fiscal Court Office, Grant County Courthouse, 101 North Main Street, Wilkesboro, Kentucky 40390 or within three (3) days of the date of the opening. Bids must be clearly marked "Grant County Turn-Key System Bid" at a minimum, all equipment bid must BE A LUMP SUM AMOUNT and must include, at a minimum, all equipment installation, training, on-site system optimization, equipment demonstration, finished assembly, detection, operation manuals and wiring diagrams) in both hard copy and electronic format with enough detail to support the training of maintenance personnel as well as support knowledge and understanding of the specifications and requirements for the system. Bidder must all defend specifications. Grant County EMA of Kentucky intends to purchase commercial, off-the-shelf (COTS) equipment from a proven qualified supplier. Therefore, the bidder must demonstrate a minimum of five (5) years of experience in similar systems. Grant County EMA of Kentucky intends to purchase a complete turn-key system (equipment and services) from a single bidder. Our preference would be to purchase from the original manufacturer of the equipment and request that they take responsibility of managing the installation and full implementation of the system.

Lump Sum Bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or a certified check in an amount equal to the amount of the bid to insure the execution of the contract for which the bid is made. In cases the bid is not accepted, the check or bid bond will be returned to the bidder. If the bid is accepted and the bidder shall refuse or neglect to enter into a contract with the Grant County Fiscal Court within ten (10) days after the time he has been notified of the acceptance of his bid, the bid check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Grant County Fiscal Court as liquidated damages for the failure to do so.

No bidder may withdraw his lump sum bid for a period of ninety (90) days after closing the books for the receipt of bids. State and federal prevailing wage rates will apply to the project and are enclosed in the bid packet.

A Bid Packet including a complete project description, technical specifications of seismic equipment and the required LUMP SUM BIDDING FORMS are available at the office of the Grant County Fiscal Court between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday except the bid process is open. The required quantity of bid forms is available to the bidder to be delivered within 90 days of award. Lump Sum Bid will be awarded to the firm or individual who presents the lowest responsive and responsible bid. Minority firms are encouraged to bid this project. The Grant County Fiscal Court reserves the right to void anticompetitive and to reject any and all bids. This purchase public warning system project is being funded by a grant through FEMA.
