Corporation for Deviation from Its Testing of Meters Occasioned by Implementation of Its Advanced Metering Infrastructure System

An informal conference ("IC") was held between Commission Staff and representatives of South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative ("South Kentucky") on November 23, 2010 at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. The purpose of the IC was for Commission Staff to ask a number of clarifying questions regarding South Kentucky's application in the above-styled case. A list of attendees is attached to this memorandum.

Commission Staff asked whether South Kentucky could ask Shelby Energy Cooperative's contractor, STS, to give them a bid for meter testing that might approximate the \$1.35 per meter cost that Shelby Energy was able to obtain from STS for its AMI meter replacement program.

South Kentucky agreed to contact STS to inquire about meter testing and to file the results of that inquiry into the record of this matter.

South Kentucky asked whether the Commission might approve a modification of its sample meter testing program whereby South Kentucky would randomly choose the proper amount of meters to fulfill the sample meter testing requirement. Commission Staff advised South Kentucky that such a modification would not likely be acceptable because it would skew the statistical results of the testing program.

The meeting was then adjourned.
