Informal Conference

An informal conference was held in this matter on Monday, October 18, 2010. Representatives of Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc. (“Clark Energy”) and Commission Staff were present for this meeting. An attendance list is attached. The purpose of the conference was to discuss the incident involved in this case.

The conference was opened by Commission Staff. Clark Energy was asked whether it had implemented any changes as a result of this accident. Representatives of Clark Energy proceeded to describe some changes that were made, including heightened scrutiny of its contractors and their qualifications. Clark Energy described how it has begun requiring safety pre-qualifications for contract bids and that contractors must submit employee qualifications prior to starting work. Clark Energy also reserves the right to deny any contractor employee access and permission to work on the system and it will begin performing monthly safety audits on crews and contractors.

Settlement negotiations were also discussed and the meeting was adjourned.
