SUBJECT: Application of Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc. For A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity For Construction of Fiber-To-The-Home in McCreary County, Kentucky

On June 10, 2010, representatives from Commission Staff met with representatives from Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc., ("Highland") to discuss Highland's application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") to construct fiber-to-the-home ("FTTH").

Commission Staff noted that Highland's application was deficient and could not be approved for filing because it did not contain certified plans for the proposed construction. Commission Staff inquired as to Highland's intention on filing the requested plans.

Highland discussed the possibility that the plans may be identical to those filed in another CPCN application case (2009-00048) and whether those plans would suffice. Commission Staff advised that a filing alerting Commission Staff to those plans and where they could be located might be sufficient to cure the deficiency.

Highland stated that it would make the necessary filings to cure the deficiency.

Thereafter the informal conference adjourned.



