


RENEWED JOINT MOTION TO ABATE

Pursuant to an agreement between the parties and their joint status report filed in this case on November 14, 2011, and the Commission’s Order entered on April 27, 2012, Nexus Communications, Inc. and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky file this renewed joint motion to abate the proceedings regarding the instant matter before the Commission pending a Commission order on the merits in Case Nos. 2010-00023 and 2010-00026 currently pending before the Commission.

AT&T Kentucky retains the right to move the Commission to lift the abeyance if Nexus does not pay on a timely basis all amounts billed by AT&T Kentucky without withholding amounts it disputes. During the abatement period, the parties also agree to continue settlement discussions in an effort to resolve the dispute without further intervention of the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the parties move the Commission to issue an order placing this case in abeyance pending further notice from the parties that the case should resume before the Commission or that the matter has been resolved.


