Dear Mr. Derouen:

Due to recent information that we received, BSWD would like to revise Case #2010-00483. The City of Kenova has removed the .10 cent per thousand surcharge due to arrearage owed to Municipal Bond Commission being satisfied. As you can see from Exhibit A, we changed from \$1.79 and .10 cent per thousand surcharge to \$1.79 per thousand. The resulting changes between Case #2010-00483 and this information create a decrease in the purchase water adjustment of .05 cents per thousand. Our total expenses and revenue have been furnished to PSC in our annual report. Enclosed are the original and ten copies of the applications, exhibits, and new tariff sheets. 

**REPORT OF CITY OF KENOVA REGARDING SURCHARGE
TO ELIMINATE ARREARAGE TO MUNICIPAL BOND COMMISSION**

In Case No. 08-1334-W-MA, the following surcharge was approved to eliminate the City of
Kenova's ("Kenova") arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission.

\$0.024 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to residential,
commercial, and industrial customers, from the effective date of the
tariff, will be charged in order to eliminate the arrearage to the
Municipal Bond Commission.

\$0.10 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to all resale customers,
from the effective date of the tariff will be charged in order to
eliminate the arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission.

Kenova attaches hereto as "Exhibit A," a report of surcharge activity from July 1, 2009 to September
30, 2010. As the arrearage owed to the Municipal Bond Commission has now been satisfied,
Kenova has removed the surcharge, effective in the billing cycles beginning on November 19, 2010.

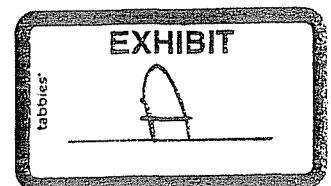

WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT FOR THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF WATER is made and entered into this the 16 day of August, 2010, by and between THE RATTLESNAKE RIDGE WATER DISTRICT, a water district created and existing under the Laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as "Seller", and the BIG SANDY WATER DISTRICT, a municipality, hereinafter referred to as "Purchaser";

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual agreements herein and contingent upon approval by Commonwealth of Kentucky Public Service Commission and the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development:

1. Seller agrees to furnish the Purchaser, at the point of delivery hereinafter specified, during the term of this Contract, potable, treated water at times and in quantities to be determined in Seller's sole and absolute discretion.
2. The water made available under this Agreement is only for use by retail customers of the Purchaser and may not be sold on a wholesale basis to any other utility.
3. Seller has no obligation to furnish satisfactory quantity or pressure for any purpose.
4. The Purchaser will keep Seller advised of all significant events which are likely to significantly affect the Purchaser's level of water purchased from the Seller.
5. The Master Meter(s) shall be read on the 15th day of each month. The Purchaser has the right to be present at each reading. The Purchaser shall pay the rate of \$2.96 per 1,000 gallons (plus any taxes, fees, etc., which are required by law) to which payment is to be received by the 10th of the following month.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed by its duly authorized officers, on this the day and date first above written.
