COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD DATA REQUEST TO
KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due no later than ten days from the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

KU shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which KU fails or

refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. The Notarized Proof of Publication submitted by KU indicated that notice of hearing in the above-referenced matter was published in a newspaper in Florence, Boone County, Kentucky. The Invoice from the Kentucky Press Service listed "Florence – Classified"¹ in a newspaper in Boone County, Kentucky, with the cover sheet listing the publications as "Florence Boone Co."² The parent company of *The Kentucky Enquirer* publishes three newspapers in Boone County.³ These publications are *The Boone County Recorder*, *The Florence Recorder*, and *The Boone Community Recorder*. Provide the name of the newspaper in Boone County that published KU's notice of the March 22, 2011 hearing.

2. Neither KU's 2009 Annual Report nor its 2010 Annual Report indicate that it serves customers in Boone County, Kentucky. State whether KU serves any customers in Boone County, Kentucky.


