**ORDINANCE NO. 10.630.1**

This Ordinance shall apply to all areas of special flood hazard within the jurisdiction of McLean County, as identified by the Federal Insurance Administration, and mandates that no structure or land in said areas shall hereafter be located, altered, extended, converted or structurally altered without compliance with its provisions; requires the obtaining of a permit from the Judge/Executive or designee as administrator and the Kentucky Division of Water; permitting of manufactured homes within areas of special flood hazard; requires that all new construction and substantial improvements be constructed with materials and utility equipment resistant to flood damage; provides that in all areas of special flood hazard...

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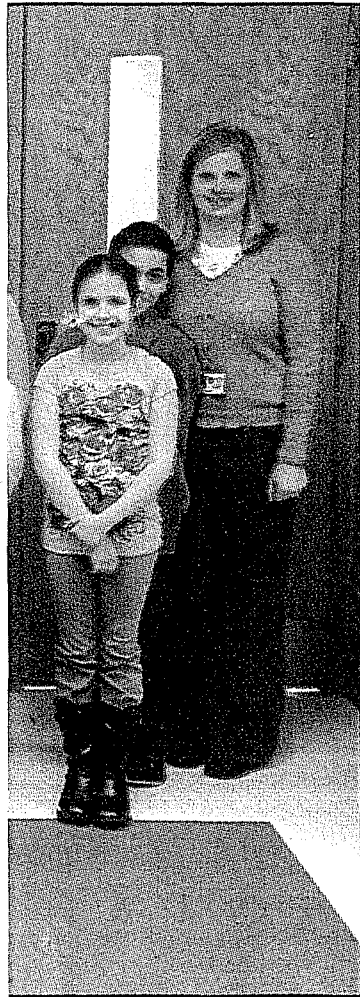

Much of the gain is due to strong sales to other countries. U.S. beef exports totaled 2.3 billion pounds in 2010, a 19 percent increase from 2009, according to the U.S. Agriculture Department.

About 66 percent of the exports went to Mexico, Canada, Japan and Korea, although sales to Asia, Egypt and Russia were higher last year, the agency said. Overseas customers also have benefited from favorable exchange rates.

In the months ahead, supplies of cattle in feedlots are expected to be tighter but demand likely will continue to improve, said Dennis Smith, senior account executive at Archer Daniels Midland Services Inc.

In other trading, oil prices fell after the government said crude oil inventories increased last week.

Traders also monitored developments in the Middle East and North Africa, where weeks of unrest showed no signs of easing. Investors were worried about supply disruptions in the oil-rich region.

Anti-government unrest has shut down most of Libya's crude oil production. Forces loyal to Moammar Gadhafi struck an oil pipeline and a storage facility as they attacked rebels in at least two major cities.

Benchmark West Texas Intermediate crude for April delivery lost 10 cents to settle at \$104.38 a barrel on the New York Mercantile Exchange.
