
Pursuant to the Rules Governing Tariffs (effective August 4, 1984), I hereby certify that I am Matthew D. Wesolosky, Vice President-Controller for Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta"), a utility furnishing natural gas service within the Commonwealth of Kentucky which, on the 7 day of June 2011, filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the approval of a revised gas cost recovery tariff and that notice to the public of the filing of the application has been completed in compliance with Section 8 of said Regulation, and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10 (3) and (4), as follows:

That more than twenty (20) customers will be affected by said revision, and that on May 4, May 11 and May 18, 2011, notice of the proposed revision, a copy of which is attached hereto, was included with customer billings and mailed to each of Delta's customers whose rates will be affected by the proposed revision to the gas cost recovery tariff.



NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. seeks approval by the Public Service Commission, Frankfort, Kentucky, of a revised Gas Cost Recovery Tariff to become effective on the date ordered by the Public Service Commission.

Delta Current and Proposed Tariff

Current Tariff

Delta's current Gas Cost Recovery Tariff states that gas cost recovery rates are comprised of the expected gas cost component, the supplier refund adjustment, the actual adjustment and the balance adjustment.

Proposed Tariff

Delta proposes to add a GCR carrying cost to the components of the gas cost recovery rate so that gas cost recovery rates will be comprised of the expected gas cost component, the supplier refund adjustment, the actual adjustment, the balance adjustment and the GCR carrying cost.

Due to the small potential increase in revenue resulting from the proposed tariff change and due to the unpredictability of over and under collections which will occur, Delta is unable to make a reasonable estimate of the amount of increase per customer class as required by the applicable regulation.

The estimated amount of the annual change and the average monthly bill to which the proposed tariff will apply will vary depending on the over and under collections which have occurred as a result of prior adjustments.

The proposed tariff change contained in this notice is the tariff change proposed by Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. However, the Public Service Commission may order changes that differ from the proposed tariff change in this notice.

Notice is further given that any corporation, association, body politic or person with a substantial interest in the matter may by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication of the notice of the proposed tariff change, request to intervene. The motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, and shall set forth the grounds for the request, including the status and interest of the party. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown. Any person who has been granted intervention may obtain copies of the application and any other filings made by the utility by contacting John Brown, Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc., 3617 Lexington Road, Winchester, Kentucky 40391, 859-744-6171, Ext. 109.

A copy of the application and testimony shall be available for public inspection at the offices of Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. or the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
