the White House to move the comprehensive overhaul of budget talks forward, the tax code. They've been stalled since a bipartisan group led by Vice President Joe Biden broke up last month after Ropublicans declared an impasse on taxes.
"The debt ceiling should not be something that is used as a gun agrinst the heads of the American people to extract tax breaks for corporate jet owners or oll and gas companies that are making billions of dollars," Obama said. 'T'm happy to have those debates. I think the American people are on my side on this."

Obama is seeking to reduce the deficit, in part. through new tax revenue raised by closing loopholes and tax subsidies. Among the examples the White House cites are tax benefits for companies that buy corporate jets. He alsohas called for ending subsidies to oil and gas companies, a propos. al that would gererate about $\$ 40$ billion in revenue over 10 years.

At the same time, Cantor's comments reflected important, if nuanced, flexibillty for Republicans. His earlier position was that closing loopholes should wait for a
