In response to your telephone call of November 16, 2011:

- Concerning a clarification on Question 19 of Commission Staff's First Request for Information, concerning map scale units, I am informed as follows:

1:2,000 is a ratio or representative fraction (RF), which indicates how many units on the earth's surface is equal to one unit

on the map. This can be translated into 1 inch on the map = 2,000 inches on the ground, which is the same as 1 inch = 167 feet.

- Concerning your question if 10 copies of maps are required, I am informed that at this juncture, 3 copies of maps are sufficient. However, additional copies of the maps may be requested in the future, if needed.
