On September 22, 2011, the Commission held an informal teleconference in this case in the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. Present were Commission Staff and Jack Hughes, attorney for Kentucky Frontier Gas LLC ("Ky Frontier"), and Bob Oxford, Steve Shute, Larry Rich and Dennis Horner, representatives of Ky Frontier who attended by phone.

Commission Staff and representatives of Ky Frontier, the court appointed operator of B.T.U. Gas Company, Inc. ("BTU"),<sup>1</sup> discussed the notice requirement for BTU's proposed Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") Tariff. KY Frontier indicated its intent to file a GCA application pursuant to its proposed tariff as soon as the notice requirement is met in order to adjust BTU's rates to reflect its most current gas cost.
