

Please find attached the final reports for 2012 water rates for Rowan and Bath water which can be forwarded to Rowan and Bath water.

Following are a summary of observations regarding the change in the rates:

- Overall gallons of water billed increased 4%, 53M gallons for the year, compared to about 6M gallon decrease in the prior year. This is a fairly large increase compared to the past several years. Most of this increase was due to Rowan Water's increased consumption of about 54M gallons. Bath Water and MUPB had small variances from the prior year.
- 2 Water department operational expenses increased by \$177,000 or 11.5% for the year.
- 3 Administrative expenses increased overall by \$3,500 (.5%.)

Combining these changes resulted in an increase in the per thousand gallon charge for water from \$1.03 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.087 per 1,000 gallons (5.5%). The increase in the per 1,000 charge should result in additional combined revenue from both Rowan and Bath water of approximately \$60,000.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that our utility, Mt. Sterling Water and Sewer, recently completed a cost of service study, related to both retail and wholesale rates. The results of this study indicated that a rate modification was justifiable. A tariff has been filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) asking for approval to alter our current wholesale rates from \$2.07/1,000 gallons to \$2.34, an increase of 13 percent. We have requested approval that this increase be effective May 1, 2011, should this increase be approved it will be reflected in the June billing.

This notice is being provided in order to comply with a PSC statute requiring that effected wholesale customers received notice of any increase a minimum of 30 days prior to the implementation of said increase.
