RE: Informal Conference of October 24, 2012

On October 24, 2012, an informal conference was held in this matter to review the current status of this case. Attending the conference were:

John Baughman	-	Appalachian Waste Control
Michael Endicott	-	Thelma Waste Control
Gerald Wuetcher	-	Commission Staff

Mr. Endicott participated by telephone.

Beginning the conference, Mr. Wuetcher also stated that Commission Staff would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of the minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes.

Mr. Baughman advised that a tentative agreement has been reached with Paintsville Utilities for the municipal utility to provide utility service to the customers of the Neal Price Estates Subdivision and the Thelma Subdivision. Johnson County Judge/Executive R.T. Daniel had agreed in principle to the proposed extension of service. Mr. Endicott stated that a meeting with the Paintsville Utilities Commission on October 5, 2012 to discuss the possible extension of service. Paintsville Utilities Commission indicated a willingness to provide service to both subdivisions.

Mr. Baughman stated that he will shortly make a formal request to the Paintsville Utility Commission for extension of service to the two subdivisions. In that request, he will provide an estimate of the cost of the proposed extension and a statement as to the resources currently available to finance the cost of the extension. Mr. Baughman noted that the Division of Water has committed \$50,000 towards the cost of the extension. Mr. Baughman will also propose a timetable for the proposed extension. He expects the extension to occur by the end of 2013.

The participants agreed that another status conference should be held within 120 days. Mr. Wuetcher stated that notice of such conference will be provided to the parties at least 30 days in advance.

The conference then adjourned.
