Dear Mr. Derouen:

The purpose of this letter is twofold. First, pursuant to the notice of deficiency dated August 20, 2012 in regard to the above matter, enclosed for filing is one (1) original and five (5) copies of Johnson County Gas Company’s (“Johnson County”) Customer Notice of Proposed Rate Increase (“Notice”) (See Tab 1). The enclosed document was inadvertently omitted from Johnson County’s August 10, 2012 amended application filing.

Second, please be advised that Johnson County was informed yesterday, August 27, 2012, that its Notice was not published for three consecutive weeks in the Paintsville Herald, the newspaper of general circulation in its service area, as required by 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5(2)(b). Johnson County requested that the Paintsville Herald publish the Notice on August 8th, August 15th and August 22nd and called to confirm publication prior to each requested publication date. Johnson County was assured by the Paintsville Herald via telephone that the Notice ran on each occasion. However, due solely to an error by the Paintsville Herald, the Notice was in fact only published on August 8th and August 15th. Please find enclosed a letter from the Paintsville Herald confirming the error (See Tab 2).

Accordingly, Johnson County has arranged to publish the Notice in the Paintsville Herald on Wednesday, August 29th. After the Notice runs for the third and final time on August 29th, Johnson County will submit an affidavit from the Paintsville Herald verifying the dates of publication. If the foregoing is insufficient, please inform us as soon as possible so that we may arrange for the Notice to be published on three consecutive weeks.

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION OF
JOHNSON COUNTY GAS
TO ADJUST RATES FOR GAS SERVICE
BEFORE THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF
THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY**

Johnson County Gas has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky seeking approval to adjust its rates for gas service within its designated service territory in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. If Johnson County Gas's application is accepted, monthly gas bills from Johnson County Gas will be affected as follows:

Residential Customers	
Present Rate – Minimum Bill 0-1 Mcf	\$11.8031/Mcf
Present Rate – All additional Mcf	\$10.8031/Mcf
Amount of Proposed Increase	\$1.2900/Mcf
*Proposed Rate – Minimum Bill 0-2 Mcf	\$13.0931/Mcf (10.9% increase)
Proposed Rate – All additional Mcf	\$12.0931/Mcf (11.9% increase)
Average Customer Bill Increase	\$6.63/month
Commercial Customers	
Present Rate – All Mcf	\$11.1531/Mcf
Amount of Proposed Increase	\$1.2900/Mcf
Proposed Rate – All Mcf	\$12.4431/Mcf (11.6% increase)
Average Customer Bill Increase	\$8.90/month

*Note that the minimum monthly charge for residential customers is increasing from 1 Mcf per customer per month to 2 Mcf per customer per month.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Johnson County Gas, but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice. Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may submit a written request to intervene in the proceedings at the Public Service Commission.
