

Kentucky Baptists are losing more staff

27 convention workers will depart amid budget crunch

ern Baptist Convention. Several other state and regional conventions have made similar plans to cut their share of funding, most stating a desire to send more funds to international missions. Seventeen of those departing the Kentucky convention staff were eligible for early-retirement incentives, which were offered to workers who turn 60 this year.

"This is the first step in a bold journey of change, but it is not without sadness," Chitwood said in a statement. "Some of these staff members have served with the KBC for decades, and Kentucky Baptists, myself included, owe them a debt of gratitude for the work they have done in service to Christ."

The incentives included full retirement benefits regardless of years of service. The package also included additional cash incentives per year of service. Employees under 60

The Kentucky Baptist Convention will lose nearly one-third of its full-time staff through early retirements and other departures in the second year at the state's largest religious body.

Twenty-three full-time workers and four part-time employees are stepping down, according to an announcement Monday by the state affiliate of the Southern Baptist Convention. The convention claims 75,000 members in about 2,400 churches.

The convention offered early retirement incentives for workers 60 and older and early resignation incentives for the rest.

With the cuts, 43 full-time staff members remain at the Kentucky Baptist Building in Louisville and eight full-time Baptist campus ministers serving on Kentucky's university and college campuses.

The Kentucky convention voted at its annual meeting in 2010 to shift more of its money away from state programs to those operated by Southern Baptists' national offices, which include missions, seminars and policy advocacy.

Those changes went into effect at the start of the current fiscal year in September 2011, when the state convention cut five full-time and 19 part-time positions, mainly through attrition, and implemented a salary freeze.

Then the convention offered the departure incentives, citing declines in church giving.
