EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.'S
MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by and through counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an Order enlarging the time by which EKPC must comply with the Commission's December 4, 2012 Order, for a period of ten (10) additional days, or to December 20, 2012.

In support of this Motion, EKPC states that the Commission entered its Order on December 4, 2012 directing that EKPC respond to requests which sought information concerning emission testing that EKPC has conducted, or intends to conduct, to determine the best way to achieve compliance with the Mercury and Air Toxic Standards, as well as emission rate and annual emissions from EKPC's coal fired generating units; and, annual environmental capital expenditures for each year from 2012 – 2016 for each of EKPC's coal units.


The Commission's Order directed that these items be produced by EKPC only six days later. Considering the extra days which it took for EKPC to actually receive and be provided notice of the Commission's Order, it is unduly burdensome for EKPC to be required to respond to all of these items in such a short period.

In addition, the Commission's Order requires EKPC to provide certain information which EKPC has previously claimed are subject to the attorney-client privilege or the attorney work product rule. EKPC needs additional time to evaluate this portion of the Order and the information which the Order requires be produced.

WHEREFORE, EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission sustain EKPC's Motion for Enlargement of Time to provide that EKPC will not be required to comply with the December 4, 2012 Order until December 20, 2012.


