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

Comes the Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties, Inc. (CAC), the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Intervenors herein, by counsel, and notify the Commission of their joint concurrence in the Notice of Agreed Resolution, Request for Relief from Procedural Schedule and Request for Termination of Case filed with the Commission by Kentucky American Water Company on May 15, 2012. This Statement is filed pursuant to footnote 4 of the Commission's May 25, 2012 Order.

The Notice of Agreed Resolution states that KAWC has created an exemption for its low-income customers who receive assistance with paying their water bills. The additional language creating the exemption is stated in tariff sheet No. 58.6, which is attached to the May 15, 2012 Notice of Agreed Resolution. The proposed exemption language is acceptable to Intervenors, and if approved by the Commission will resolve Intervenors' concerns in this matter.
