Mr. Halbert:

Bids for the Harold Sewer Project Contract 1 were opened at Southern Water's office at 11:00A.M. on March 29, 2012. The attendance list is attached as **Exhibit 'A'**. This was the second bid opening for this contract as only one bid was opened on the first bid opening of 3/6/12 and it was high.

A certified tabulation of the bids received is attached hereto as **Exhibit 'B'**. One bid was received for this project during the second opening. The apparent low for the project is H20 Construction Company, Inc. of Mare Creek, Floyd County, Kentucky (Base Bid: \$1,897,500.00, With Deducts: \$1,790,000.00).

**EVALUATION OF LOW BIDDER**

**1. Experience**

H20 has worked previously for the Southern Water and Sewer District. H20 constructed the Eastern Sewer Project in 2008, consisting of one 25,000 gpd precast concrete package wastewater treatment plant and small pressure sewer collection system serving 42 customers. H20 is highly experienced with sanitary sewer collection system projects and has various experience working and installing precast concrete treatment plants.

**2. Bid Bond**

H20 furnished bonds drawn on the Merchants Bonding Company (Mutual) NAIC #14494. This bonding company is on the Treasury Departments 570 list.

**3. Bidders Questionnaire**

H20 signed the site and contract document certificates, furnished sufficient bid bonds, and provided adequate information on the contractor's questionnaire. H20 has visited the site, is comfortable with what is required, and has furnished a list of reference projects that satisfies the experience requirements. H20 owns a substantial amount of heavy machinery available to be used on the project

and anticipates using some subcontractors to perform small portions of the work including electrical work.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

H20's base bid is over the Engineer's estimate. Follow up phone calls were made to Howard Engineering & Construction and Kenney Incorporated and learned that they both planned on completing bids until the morning of the bid opening. Both Contractors bids were going to exceed \$2,000,000 which was well over the Engineer's estimate, and because they attended the second pre-bid meeting, and understood the financial situation of the project, decided not to bid.

We are comfortable that the bid received from H20 construction is the most competitive bid that will be received for this contract and no more re-bids are recommended. Also, our research has not disclosed any grounds for disqualification of H20's bid.

It is our opinion that award of the "base bid with ALL deducts removed" be made to H20 Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of (\$1,790,000.00) is in the best interest of the project.

We would recommend that SWSD make a "contingent" award and give Hubert Halbert authorization to deliver award notice when SRF has committed the additional requested loan dollars.

**The contract documents provide for a ninety (90) day bid hold.** The last day to award the contracts is June 27, 2012.


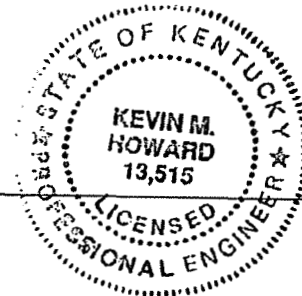

Bids for the Harold Sewer Project Contract 2 were opened at Southern Water's office at 2:00 P.M. on March 6, 2012. The attendance list is attached as Exhibit 'A'.

A certified tabulation of the bids received is attached hereto as **Exhibit 'B'**. Five (5) bids were received for this project. The apparent low for the project is Drains Unlimited Inc. of Prestonsburg, Kentucky (Base Bid: \$1,561,692.25).

### EVALUATION OF LOW BIDDER

#### 1. Experience

Drains Unlimited (Drains) has worked previously for the Southern Water and Sewer District. Drains constructed a large water line extension project, consisting of approximately 48,000 LF of water line and six (6) small water booster pumping stations.

Drains has performed extensive site grade and drain contract work for Kinzer Drilling for the past 7-8 years. We interviewed Doug Hyden at Kinzer Drilling (606-874-8041) regarding Drains work history with Kinzer. Doug is satisfied with Drains quality of work regarding site grading and drainage for all their new gas well sites in the last 7-8 years (+/-100 new well sites have been constructed by Drains). He did specifically advise that the work is not necessarily complex, but is in a large volume. As far as Doug knew, Drains had not completed any other water or sewer line construction projects with the exception of the SWSD water line project in the history of the company. Please note that Drains has NOT constructed any gas lines for Kinzer drilling.

Drains has also performed miscellaneous drain tile installation projects for the Floyd County Fiscal Court over the recent years and has a good working relationship with the County.

Based on our reference checking, it is our understanding that Drains has not constructed any sewer projects in the past and has only completed one water line project in their company history.

#### 2. Bid Bond

Drains furnished a cashier's check for the amount of (\$77,192.62) for their 5% bid bond. Drains has assured us that they will be using a bonding company for their performance and payment bonds and it will be on the circular 570 surety list.

### 3. Bidders Questionnaire

Drains signed the site and contract document certificates, furnished sufficient bid bonds, and provided adequate information on the contractor's questionnaire. Drains has visited the site, is comfortable with what is required. Drains supplied us with three references for work experience and all returned favorable opinions of Drains quality of work, however little of the work included work related to pipe laying or extensive electrical and plumbing work, it is our opinion that Drains has the manpower and equipment to complete the work as bid.

### RECOMMENDATION

In summary, Drains Unlimited is a local contractor of good report. Drains Unlimited submittals have complied with the Instructions to Bidders. Drains Unlimited has tendered a low bid that suggests extensive experience in the construction of sanitary sewers. However, our research reveals that Drains Unlimited is relatively inexperienced in the construction of sanitary sewers. In our experience, a low bid coupled with limited experience is generally a bad combination. That said, we have communicated this concern to Drains Unlimited and been assured that Drains Unlimited will add crew members with extensive sewer experience to their team prior to construction start.

It is also our understanding that Southern Water strongly desires to proceed to construction with Drains Unlimited. We concur in award to Drains Unlimited subject to the following:

1. **Scope of Work.** Since limited funds are available for construction, the award must be limited to \$1,315,156. This may be accomplished by dropping lines 'C', 'D', 'F' and 'H' from the project and reducing line 'B' trunk lines by roughly 2,600 hundred feet. See **Exhibit 'C'**.
2. **Funding Agency Concurrence.** The Public Service Commission and funding agencies must concur in the award before Southern forwards a Notice of Award to Drains Unlimited.

We would recommend that Southern make a 'contingent' award (to satisfy DOW ATA guidelines) and give Mr. Halbert the authority to deliver a formal Notice of Award when Condition 2 is satisfied.

The contract documents provide for a ninety (90) day bid hold. The last day to award the contracts is June 4, 2012.


