**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively, “LG&E - KU”), by and through their respective counsel, move the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to extend the time for LG&E-KU to file their testimony or comments in this proceeding through and until October 1, 2012. As grounds for this joint motion, movants state that following the exchange of information between LGE-KU and EKPC, certain technical issues arose concerning the data. LG&E-KU and EKPC have diligently and in good faith discussed and resolved these technical issues. The resolution of the data issues, however, delayed LG&E-KU from undertaking its analysis and report, and a brief amount of additional time therefore is required for LG&E-KU to complete the analysis and prepare testimony. The Joint Motion for Extension of Time is not made for the purpose of unduly delaying the Commission’s examination and if granted will not prejudice the Commission’s ability to conduct its examination of EKPC’s application.

**WHEREFORE**, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc., Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company move the Public Service Commission to grant Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company an extension of time through October 1, 2012 to file testimony or comments in this proceeding.


