On May 7, 2012, Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation ("Jackson Energy") submitted a revised Sample Meter Testing Plan for approval by the Commission. - 3. Jackson Energy is to continue testing its meters in accordance with the Sample Meter Testing Plan previously filed with and approved by the Commission.
