**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO DEVIATE FROM FILING REQUIREMENTS**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, for leave to deviate from the filing requirements established in this proceeding with respect to the Company’s response KIUC 1-1. Specifically, Kentucky Power requests that it be excused from filing paper copies of the response because the response is voluminous in nature. As grounds for its motion, Kentucky Power states:


The Commission’s Order of June 28, 2012 requires Kentucky Power to file an original and ten copies of the response. The supporting documentation for the Company’s response to KIUC 1-1 is 653 pages. Producing an original response, along with paper copies to the parties and six paper copies to the Commission is unduly burdensome.

As a means of addressing the voluminous nature of the filing, Kentucky Power requests leave to deviate from the Commission’s June 28, 2012 Order by filing a paper

“original” with the Commission, serving paper copies on the parties of record, and submitting ten electronic copies to the Commission.<sup>1</sup>

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power requests leave to deviate from the Commission’s filing requirements as set forth above.

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
