PETITION FOR LEAVE TO DEVIATE FROM FILING REQUIREMENTS

Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, for leave to deviate from the filing requirements established in this proceeding with respect to the Company's August 27, 2012 Supplemental Response KIUC 1-1. Specifically, Kentucky Power requests that it be excused from filing paper copies of the response because the response is voluminous in nature. As grounds for its motion, Kentucky Power states:


The Commission's Order of June 28, 2012 requires Kentucky Power to file an original and ten copies of the response. The supporting documentation for the Company's August 27, 2012 Supplemental Response to KIUC 1-1 is 773 pages. Producing an original response, along with a paper copy to the party and ten paper copies to the Commission is unduly burdensome.

As a means of addressing the voluminous nature of the filing, Kentucky Power requests leave to deviate from the Commission's June 28, 2012 Order by filing a paper

“original” with the Commission, serving paper copies on the party of record, and submitting ten electronic copies to the Commission.¹

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power requests leave to deviate from the Commission’s filing requirements as set forth above.

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
