NOTICE

The City of Liberty has filed a proposed rate schedule with the Public Service Commission which will increase the rate for water service provided as follows:

	<u>Current Rate</u>	<u>Proposed Rate</u>	<u>% Difference</u>
East Casey County Water District	\$2.38 per 1000 gallons	\$2.55 per 1000 gallons	7% Increase

The proposed effective date is July 1, 2012. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rate. Water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the new proposed rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Liberty. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.
