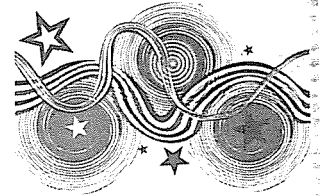
credit in the amount of \$23,800, One hundred percent of the original bond amount is included in this application for Phase III release.
