COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO
BOOMERANG WIRELESS, LLC

Boomerang Wireless, LLC ("Boomerang"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before November 9, 2012. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Boomerang shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which


Boomerang fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request

1. Does Boomerang agree to remit the Telecommunications Relay Service/ Telecommunications Access Program ("TRS/TAP") Surcharge for each access line served, including Lifeline customers?

2. Does Boomerang agree to remit the Kentucky Universal Service Fund ("USF") Surcharge for each access line served, including Lifeline customers?

3. Does Boomerang agree to remit the statewide wireless 911 fee to the Commercial Mobile Radio Services Board ("CMRS") for each access line served, including Lifeline customers?
