The Commission Staff has reviewed Grayson R.E.C.C.'s application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(4):
Copy of public notice did not meet requirements

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(a):
Amount of change requested in dollar amounts and percentage for each customer classification to which change will apply.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(b):
Present and proposed rates for each customer class to which change would apply

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(c):
Electric, gas, water and sewer utilities – effect upon average bill for each customer class to which change will apply

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(7):
The proposed tariff in form complying with 807 KAR 5:011 which an effective date not less than thirty days from the date the application is filed.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(8):
Proposed tariff changes shown either by providing present and proposed tariffs in comparative form or indicating additions by italicized inserts or underscoring and striking over deletions in a copy of the current tariff.

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The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may re-file your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is a least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter. If you need further assistance, please contact my staff at 502-564-3940.
