15 16	Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers"), by counsel, and for its response to the
17	Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule to Allow for an Enlargement of Time Within Which to
18	File Testimony of the Attorney General ("AG"), states as follows.
19	In its motion, the AG requests that the procedural schedule be amended only as to one of
20	its witnesses, Mr. David Brevitz, so that (i) testimony from Mr. Brevitz is due a week after
21	testimony from the AG's other witnesses is due, and (ii) requests for information to Mr. Brevitz
22	are due a week after requests for information to the AG's other witnesses are due. The AG also
23	notes that the amended schedule which would apply to Mr. Brevitz would align with the
24	enlargement in time which was requested by intervenor Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers,
25	Inc. ("KIUC") in its March 21, 2013 Petition to Amend Procedural Schedule and Request for an
26	Informal Conference.
27	Big Rivers is sympathetic to the situation presented by the AG and does not object to the
28	dates that the AG has proposed. However, as it stated in its March 25 Response to KIUC's
29	petition, Big Rivers will require all of the witnesses' testimony in order to adequately prepare its
30	data requests. An enlargement in time that applies to a single witness's testimony would unduly
31	prejudice Big Rivers and result in administrative inefficiency and an unnecessarily complex

applied to Mr. Brevitz's testimony should apply to all of the intervenors' witnesses. 2 WHEREFORE, Big Rivers respectfully requests that the Commission grant the Attorney 3 General's motion by amending the procedural schedule with respect to all parties, thus requiring 4 (i) all intervenor witness testimony to be filed by April 18, 2013 and (ii) all Big Rivers' requests 5 for information to the intervenors to be filed by May 2, 2013.
