Dear Ms. Robinson:

Enclosed is a filing notice and a new tariff that FPB filed with the Public Service Commission on August 23, 2012 reflecting an increase in FPB's Kentucky River Authority Withdrawal Fee.

The KRA maintains the locks and dams that make it possible to use the Kentucky River as a water source. The KRA has the ability to collect water use fees from all facilities using water from the Kentucky River. FPB is one such facility.

The KRA fee is separate from the rates FPB charges for wholesale water service. It is a "pass through" fee. That is, FPB retains none of these funds for its operations. Rather, FPB collects these funds and remits them to the KRA.

Based on South Anderson's usage for last month, the proposed increase of 1.14 cents per 1,000 gallons will be approximately \$24.75 per month.

Due to an increase in the wholesale rate for water purchased from the Frankfort Plant Board, the South Anderson Water District has applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for a rate increase to cover its increased costs. The rates contained herein are the rates proposed by South Anderson Water District, however the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that are higher or lower than the rates proposed in this notice.
