## ORDER

Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") has requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17, requiring a statement indicating how much of the proceeds from the line of credit will be used for the acquisition of property, the construction, completion, extension or improvement of facilities, the improvement of service, the maintenance of service and the discharge of refunding obligations. Delta states that draws are made on the line of credit on an as-needed basis, and that what expenditures will be made and in what amounts are not currently known.

Finding that Delta has demonstrated good cause to permit its deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:
