ORDER

Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the conference's presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 8.0 hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's 2013 Outdoor Expo (WT 2013-010), which will be held in Park City, Kentucky, on June 11-12, 2013 is accredited and approved for a maximum of 8.0 credit hours of water district management training.

- a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;
- b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and
- c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
