ORDER

On November 18, 2013, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed a motion requesting leave to withdraw its rate application. Kentucky Power states that pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement ("Stipulation") that was filed in Case No. 2012-00578,<sup>1</sup> Kentucky Power agreed to withdraw the instant rate case upon approval of the Stipulation. In light of the October 7, 2013 Commission's Order approving the Stipulation and its November 15, 2013 Order denying the Attorney General's petition for rehearing in Case No. 2012-00578, Kentucky Power is requesting to withdraw its application in this proceeding consistent with Paragraph 3 of the Stipulation.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power has established good cause to permit it leave to withdraw its rate application in this proceeding.

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
