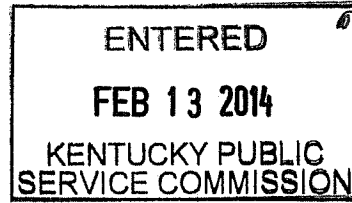
ORDER

On January 31, 2014, Kenergy Corp. (“Kenergy”) filed a motion requesting that the formal evidentiary hearing, which is scheduled for February 19, 2014, be cancelled. Kenergy states that the other parties to this matter, the Attorney General, and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc., have not filed testimony and do not have cross-examination questions for any of Kenergy’s witnesses at the hearing. Should neither the Commission nor Commission Staff have cross-examination questions for any of Kenergy’s witnesses, Kenergy requests that the formal evidentiary hearing be cancelled so that it will not incur the substantial expense of publishing notice of the hearing.


Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kenergy has established good cause to have the February 19, 2014 evidentiary hearing cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kenergy’s motion to cancel the February 19, 2014 formal evidentiary hearing is granted subject, to being rescheduled at a later date if necessary.
