**EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.'S
MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME**

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by and through counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an acknowledgement enlarging the time by which EKPC must comply with Ordering paragraph 3 of the Commission's Order dated December 20, 2012, up to and including February 28, 2013.

In support of this Motion, EKPC states that the Commission entered its Order on December 20, 2012. Ordering paragraph 3 states: "EKPC shall file within 30 days of the date of this Order any appropriate or needed amendments to existing special contracts or tariffs to reflect that EKPC is authorized to bid any customer's interruptible load into the PJM Demand Response program." EKPC and Gallatin Steel ("Gallatin"), a party to this proceeding, had numerous discussions during the evidentiary period. EKPC, Gallatin, and Owen Electric Cooperative ("Owen") began good faith contract negotiations several months ago. EKPC, Gallatin, and Owen are very close to agreeing upon and finalizing the language to be included in the contract amendment and request the additional time to provide an executed contract to the Commission, up to and including February 28, 2013.

Additionally, EKPC requests additional time, up to and including February 28, 2013, to finalize and execute the amendment to the contract by and between EKPC, Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, and AGC Automotive Americas.

EKPC will file revisions to its tariffs, in accordance with Ordering paragraph 3, on January 22, 2013.

WHEREFORE, EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission sustain EKPC's Motion for Enlargement of Time to provide that EKPC will not be required to comply to certain portions of Ordering paragraph 3 of the December 20, 2012 Order until February 28, 2013.


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
