To the Commission:

The Elkhorn Water District respectfully requests that the Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment Clause.

The District purchased 65,363,500 gallons from February 2012 to January 2013. The District sold 53,187,500 gallons to its customers. The effective cost of water purchased was 1.91 during the test period. With the wholesale increase by the Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board the new cost is expected to be 2.01 making the total new cost \$131,380.64. The difference between the old cost and the new cost is expected to be \$6,536.35; the incremented cost in terms of water sold is \$.13 per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.



BOARD RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT APPROVING APPLICATION TO THE KENTUCY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR MODIFICATION OF THE APPROPRIATE PROVISIONS OF THE ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT TARIFF SO AS TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE ORDER OF IN CASE NO. 2010-00485 ISSUED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ON MARCH 16, 2011, AND THEREBY ALLOWING ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT TO CHARGE THE ADJUSTED RATES AS THEY ARE BILLED TO ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2013, BY THE FRANKFORT PLANT BOARD

**WHEREAS.** Elkhorn Water District has entered into a stipulated agreement with the Frankfort Plant Board in Case No. 2010-00485 in regards to the wholesale water rates to be charged by Frankfort Plant Board; and


**WHEREAS,** the Kentucky Public Service Commission has adopted the stipulated agreement by Order dated March 16, 2011; and

**WHEREAS,** the Frankfort Plant Board is now authorized, on and after April 1, 2013, to charge \$2.01 per thousand gallons of water sold to Elkhorn Water District; and

**WHEREAS,** Elkhorn Water District's Board deems it appropriate and necessary to recover the increase contained in this new charge through rates charged to its customers;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT that the foregoing premises are correct and are incorporated into and made apart of this Resolution, and that the Board does authorize its chairman and staff to take such actions as are necessary, including the filing of an application for a purchased water adjustment, so that the Kentucky Public Service Commission may approve new or amended provisions of the tariff of the Elkhorn Water District whereby the full amount of the new wholesale rate charged by the Frankfort Plant Board can be charged and collected by Elkhorn Water District.
