
**Kentucky Power Company’s Response to KIUC’s  
Petition to Amend Procedural Schedule**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) has no objection to the schedule change requested in Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc.’s (“KIUC”) Petition to Amend Procedural Schedule (“Petition”) filed on June 12, 2013. Kentucky Power, however, files this response to note that its agreement to the change was conditioned on a similar one week extension for all subsequent procedural deadlines. Counsel for Kentucky Power has discussed the matter with counsel for KIUC, who has confirmed that Kentucky Power’s agreement was conditioned upon the like modification of the dates for subsequent events in the procedural schedule, and confirmed that KIUC has no objection to doing so.

As such, if the Commission were to grant KIUC’s motion, the requested schedule changes should be as follows:


