RE: Telephone Call of September 10, 2014

On or about September 10, 2014, we spoke regarding Richardsville Gas Co., Inc's ("Richardsville Gas") June 11, 2014 letter and the Commission's August 7, 2014 follow-up letter.

In the course of the call, you confirmed the intention of Richardsville Gas to withdraw the abandonment application in Case No. 2013-00234. You further stated your intention to continue operating Richardsville Gas for the next several years, subsequent to a recent rate adjustment, which will enable upgrades and improvements be made to the utility. In particular, you noted that connection to additional wells will alleviate the need to utilize propane to increase gas pressure, which will in turn increase the salability of the utility. Finally, we briefly discussed the fact that any potential sale or transfer would require Commission approval and that Staff is available to answer questions regarding any eventual transfer case.
