

JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Parties, Louisville Water Company (“LWC”) and Hardin County Water District No. 2 (“Hardin District 2”), by their respective counsel, jointly move the Commission for a 15 day extension of time in which to file their respective Memorandum of Law in this matter. For cause the Parties state as follows:

1. The legal issue to be addressed in this matter is a novel one. The outcome of this case is of critical importance not only to the Parties but also to all Commission regulated water utilities in Kentucky.

2. The Commission is seeking input from the Parties concerning whether certain obligations contained in the Water Purchase Agreement between LWC and Hardin District 2 are “evidences of indebtedness” within the meaning of KRS 278.300(1). The Commission has not yet ruled on this legal issue in any case involving water utilities.

3. This important legal issue needs to be adequately addressed. It would be a disservice to the Commission and the Parties to require the Parties to address it in a hurried fashion.

4. Counsel for LWC has been out of town for a significant portion of time since the Commission Order was issued.

5. Both counsels have also been involved in other pressing legal matters since the Commission Order was issued and have been unable to devote adequate time to this case.


6. The 15 additional days requested by the Parties will enable both counsels to complete their research and prepare their respective Memorandum of Law.

7. Since both Parties are requesting an extension of time, neither Party will be prejudiced if the Commission grants the requested extension.
