Gentlemen:

This letter is being provided in response to a telephone message left by Russell Givens earlier today.

Although both parties have indicated an agreement with the figures discussed during the December 4, 2013 informal conference, a stipulation signed by the parties has not been filed. Nothing prohibits Mr. Givens from contacting the Office of the Attorney General, or the Office of the Attorney General contacting Mr. Givens. Discussion between the parties is recommended.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076, Section 13(2) (previously, Section 12(2)), Classic Construction, Inc. must be represented at the hearing by an attorney authorized to practice law in Kentucky. Reasonable attorney expenses may be recoverable as a rate expense.


As indicated in the Commission's Order issued September 4, 2013, Classic Construction, Inc. needs to publish a notice of the scheduled hearing in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b), no more than 21 days and no less than 7 days before
