Originally EKPC installed a double circuit 345KV/138KV line and moved three sections for a total of 14,697 feet to a new centerline/ easement.

As a result EKPC's easement passes thru the middle of our front yard, and thru the carport and garage of our home. Because of this large upgrade we receive a shock if you touch the metal on a vehicle in the driveway and the E.M.F. levels have been as high as 23 milligauss inside our home. These lines now are only approximately 20 percent load capacity per EKPC. Since no CPCN was required Harold Barker, Ann Barker + Brooks Barker were denied adequate time to investigate, file claims and have a hearing with the PSC. We are filing this claim because of the health and safety concerns we have not only for ourselves but the public because of the location of these massive transmission lines.
