Come Complainants, **HAROLD BARKER, ANN BARKER and BROOKS BARKER,** by counsel, and move the Kentucky Public Service Commission for a brief continuance of the Public Hearing in the above-styled matter, stating in support hereof as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's Order entered April 7, 2014, The Public Hearing in the above-styled matter is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, July 1, 2014 at 10:00a.m., Eastern Daylight Time.

2. Other than the Defendant's responses to the Complainant's Requests for Information, which are due on June 23, 2014, all procedural steps as required by said Order have been completed.

3. Complainants recently discovered that their expert medical witness, David O. Carpenter, M.D., will be in Beijing, China on July 1, 2014 to attend a previously-scheduled conference. As a result, he will be unable to appear before the Commission on that date to testify in support of his written testimony filed earlier in this action. He is the Complainants' only medical witness and, accordingly, his oral testimony is essential to the prosecution of their Complaint.

4. According to information gained from the Commission's website, the Public

Hearing scheduled for July 8-10, 2014 in case number 2014-00002 has been cancelled. Dr. Carpenter and all other Complainants' witnesses are available for testimony either July 8th or July 9th, 2014. (They are also available on July 14-16, 2014.) This makes it possible to insure that any continuance granted would be brief.
