MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO COMMISSION’S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation (“Jackson Energy”), by and through its counsel, hereby moves the Commission for an order granting it an extension of time until January 24, 2014 to respond to the Commission’s First Request for Information. As grounds for this motion, Jackson Energy states as follows:

On November 12, 2013, Jackson Energy filed its application for approval of its Energy Retrofit Rider Tariff on a permanent basis. By letter dated November 12, 2013, the Commission acknowledged receipt of the initial application submitted by Jackson Energy. On November 27, 2013, the Commission entered an order in this matter, finding that an investigation of the proposed tariff was necessary to determine the reasonableness of the program. On December 12, 2013, the Commission filed its First Request for Information from Jackson Energy, to which responses are currently due on January 7, 2014.

As the Commission is likely aware, Jackson Energy has partnered with the Mountain Association of Community Economic Development (“M-ACED”) in Berea, Kentucky in

administering the Energy Retrofit Rider program. MACED provides much of the financing required to administer the program. Many of the information requests filed by the Commission will require Jackson Energy to consult with and obtain information from MACED. Jackson Energy has recently discussed the information requests with MACED, and it appears that given the intervening holiday season and the administrative processes within MACED, that it would be impossible to obtain the information from MACED that is required prior to January 7, 2014.

Accordingly, Jackson Energy respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order granting it additional time to answer the Commission's First Request for Information, so that the responses to that request are not due until January 24, 2014.
