Unemployment rates fell in 55-Kentucky counties between February 2013 and February 2014, while 56 county rates went up and nine counties stayed the same, according to the state's Kentucky Office of Employment and Training.

Boone County recorded the lowest jobless rate in the state at. 6.7 percent. It was followed by Oldham County, 7 percent; Fayette and Woodford counties, 7.1 percent each; Campbell, Kenton, Shelby, Warren and Webster counties, 7.3 percent each; and Simpson County, 7.4 percent.
