ORDER

On August 13, 2014, the Commission issued an Order initiating this proceeding to review East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.'s ("East Kentucky") fuel adjustment clause for the six-month period from November 1, 2013, through April 30, 2014. On August 22, 2014, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") filed a motion for full intervention in this matter ("Motion"). KIUC also filed a petition to amend the procedural schedule ("Petition"). In its Petition, KIUC stated that its inquiry would focus on the manner in which East Kentucky allocated fuel costs during the period under review.

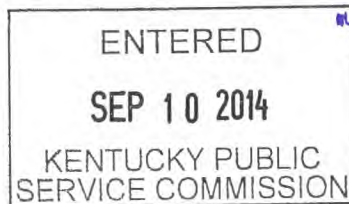
On August 28, 2014, East Kentucky filed a response in which it opposed both KIUC's Motion and Petition, arguing that KIUC wished to gather information to assist it in a separate proceeding before the Commission and noting that KIUC stated that it "has no reason to believe that EKPC's fuel cost allocation approach was unreasonable." On September 2, 2014, KIUC filed a Notice of Withdrawal ("Notice") wherein it withdrew its Motion and Petition, stating that, after reading East Kentucky's August 27, 2014

responses to the Commission's information request, it no longer had a need to be involved in this proceeding.

Having reviewed the pleadings and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission hereby finds that KIUC's Notice should be treated as a motion to withdraw and should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that KIUC's Notice of Withdrawal is granted.
