ORDER

On September 29, 2014, Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke") filed a motion, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(5), for leave to amend Exhibit 2 to its previously filed Application. Duke states that subsequent to filing its Application, Dynergy, Inc. ("Dynergy") was identified as the third-party purchaser of Duke's affiliate, Duke Energy Miami Fort, LLC. Dynergy requested and Duke agreed to certain changes to the Amended and Restated Operation Agreement. The modifications are in regard to the rights and responsibilities of the owner and operator of the Miami Fort Station's generating units upon the shutdown of units 7 and 8. Accordingly, Duke moves to substitute the originally filed Exhibit 2 with the newly filed revised Exhibit 2.

The Commission, being sufficiently advised, finds that Duke has shown good cause to amend Exhibit 2 to its Application through its replacement with a revised Exhibit 2.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Duke's motion to amend its Application through substituting Exhibit 2 filed September 29, 2014, for the Exhibit 2 filed with its original Application is granted.
