MOTION FOR CUSTOMER NOTICE DEVIATION

Comes U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties, Kentucky, Inc. ("U.S. 60"), by counsel, and respectfully requests the Commission to grant it a deviation from the notice requirements set forth in 807 KAR 5:011 § 8(2)(b)3, but only as to Franklin County, Kentucky. As grounds for this request, U.S. 60 states that a proper request for publication of the legal notice was made to The State Journal, which is the newspaper of general circulation in Franklin County. The State Journal has advised us the first advertisement was timely published on February 5, 2014, but due to a computer error in their system, the following publications were never made (see attached email thread). This mistake was discovered when we contacted the newspaper requesting an Affidavit of Publication. U.S. 60 therefore moves the Commission to grant it deviation from 807 KAR 5:011 § 8(2)(b)3 to permit U.S. 60 to satisfy the customer notice requirement as to its Franklin County customers by republishing the Legal Notice once a week for either two or three consecutive weeks in The State Journal.

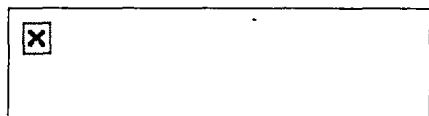
