Dear Cory:

We have prepared the accompanying Cost Review Formulas for revising calendar year wholesale rate charges as per Treated Water Sale and Purchase Agreements with the Nebo Water District.

We prepared the Cost Review Formulas using June 30, 2013 audited financial statements and wholesale user consumption records as provided by the City of Madisonville. We did not audit the wholesale user consumption records during our June 30, 2013 audit due to the fact that such records were outside the scope of the audit.

The wholesale water rate to be charged to the Nebo Water District is \$3.71 per each one thousand gallons of treated water. It is my understanding that the new rate will be charged from March 15, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

# Nebo Water District Special Called Meeting February 12, 2014

11:00 a.m.

The Nebo Water District Commissioners had a special called meeting to discuss the proposed rate increase. On February 4<sup>th</sup> the Nebo Water District received a letter from the City of Madisonville informing the District of their intention of raising the Wholesale rate by 6 cents per 1000 gallons. The Commissioners voted to increase the customer's current rate by seven cents per 1000 gallons in accordance with the formula figured by their accountant Michael L. Overby C. P. A. This increase would go into effect on March 15<sup>th</sup> 2014.

On February 18<sup>th</sup> 2014 an official from the Nebo Water District will be attending the Hopkins County Fiscal Court meeting to inform them of this increase.
