RE: Proposed Purchase Water Adjustment

To Whom It May Concern:

The West Shelby Water District respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustments for Water Districts.

Our supplier, The Louisville Water Company, has informed the District that an increase will take effect July 1, 2014. The District purchased 270,916,100 gallons of water from May 1, 2013 to April 30, 2014 at a total cost of \$553,034.77 The District sold 246,226,410 gallons of water to its customers. With the wholesale increase the new cost is expected to be \$565,775.57. The difference between the current cost and proposed cost will be \$12,740.80. The incremental cost in terms of water sold is \$0.0517 cents per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.



On behalf of Louisville Water Company, thank you for attending the meeting of our wholesale customers earlier this week. I appreciate the opportunity for feedback from this important customer group.

As previously discussed at the above meeting, the wholesale commodity charge effective July 1, 2014 will be \$1.80 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.30 per thousand gallons.

We are planning to file the necessary documentation for this new rate with the Public Service Commission over the next few weeks. The PSC advised us in the past that we must inform you of the proposed rate increase in the format of the notice attached on the next page, although we have already provided notice to you at our wholesale customer meeting February 25, 2014.

## NOTICE

The Louisville Water Company has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase by 2.5% the rate(s) which it currently charges to West Shelby Water District for water service.

Louisville Water Company currently charges West Shelby Water District a \$148.40 monthly meter fee, a \$254.40 monthly meter fee, \$1.75 per thousand gallons, and \$0.30 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.05 per thousand gallons.

Louisville Water Company proposes to charge West Shelby Water District a \$161.88 monthly meter fee, a \$277.50 monthly meter fee, and \$1.80 per thousand gallons, and \$0.30 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.10 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2014.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Louisville Water Company. The Public Service Commission, however, may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.



**Ray Larmee, Commission Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.**

## **Reading of Minutes**

Ray made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 2014 meeting. Ben seconded the motion.

## **Business:**

**Purchase Water Adjustment** - Louisville Water Company (LWC) has filed for a rate increase with the Public Service Commission (PSC) increasing our wholesale rates from \$2.05 to \$2.10 per 1,000 gallons of water purchased. Ray made a motion to submit a purchase water adjustment to PSC to reflect the LWC rate increase. Ben seconded the motion.

**Horizon Phase II** – Chris presented the final pay estimate and contract change order for signing. The pay estimate was for \$32,016.16 payable to Hubert Excavating, \$5706.93 payable to Kenvirons, and the change order was for \$11,008.46. After being reviewed by the Commissioners, all documents were approved for signing. Steve stated that the contract total increased because of state road changes that were beyond our control. Chris also gave WSWD a copy of the Final Release of Lien Waiver from Huber Excavating.

**Recycling Center** – Steve stated that the new recycling center is asking that WSWD order the vault they are going to be using to our specifications and they will pay for it. Ben motioned to request a purchase order from the county specifying that it is for material only, and proceed with the purchase. Ray seconded the motion.

**Simpsonville Line Improvement-** Steve asked the Commissioners if there were any objections doing the project in phases.
